The Convention shall be held for the purpose of:

- Endorsing the Republican candidate for Congress in the 3rd Congressional District
- Electing delegates and alternates to the Republican National Convention in July
- Electing a Presidential Elector from the 3rd Congressional District
- Considering resolutions to propose amending the MN Republican Party Platform
- Considering a proposed amendment to the CD3 Constitution concerning Presidential Electors
- Transaction of any other business as may properly come before the convention

*The deadline for **US Congressional candidates** to notify CD3 of the intent to seek Republican endorsement at the CD3 Convention is **Saturday, April 20**. Notification must be provided by submitting the form [at the bottom of the "About" page](#) on the 3rd Congressional District Republicans webpage. **This is a firm deadline. Names cannot be submitted at the Convention.** The Nominations Committee will schedule mandatory interviews with candidates.*

*The deadline for applying to be a **delegate or alternate at the Republican National Convention** was published by the MN Republican Party as **March 31**. No further applications will be accepted.*

*The deadline for applying to be the **Presidential Elector for the 3rd Congressional***

District will be Sunday, April 21 no later than 5:00 PM. This is a firm deadline. Names cannot be submitted at the Convention. Application must be made using the form at **the [bottom of the "About" page](#)** on the 3rd Congressional District Republicans website. Applicants **are also asked to submit** (1) a summary in bullet point of work done by the applicant for party units and/or candidates, and (2) a short essay of no more than 150 words on why the applicant believes they should be elected the Presidential Elector. These should be submitted to Chair Randy Sutter by email to randywacs@aol.com.

The Nominations Committee will schedule mandatory interviews with Presidential Elector candidates and the support material will be published online for review by convention delegates and alternates.
