2024 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY RESULTS

Former President Donald Trump easily won the Republican Presidential Primary on March 5th setting up a rematch with President Biden in November. Former U.N. Ambassador Nikki Haley of South Carolina wasn't able to dislodge Trump from the top of the ticket.

MNGOP submitted five Republican candidates to the Secretary of State's office to appear on the ballot prior to some of them suspending their campaigns:


